





Online Resources Purchasing Options

- ✓ Subscription to selected subject modules
- ✓ Perpetual Access one time purchase, usually to collection, sold by subject and publication year
- ✓ Title-by-Title pick and choose individual titles available for OSO/UPSO, ORO, OxMed, OxPsych
- ✓ Evidence Based Acquisition EBA allows libraries access to a collection of ebooks for a fixed period and then make final purchasing decisions after evaluating usage data available for OSO, OxMed, OxPsych.









Title-by-Title (TbT) at OUP

TbT option available for OSO/UPSO, ORO, OxMed, OxPsych

- Sent bibliographic data of the requested title to your Sales Contact at OUP together with the preferred user access option
- Sales Contact will check if the TbT option is available for the selected title and will provide a quote
- Availability of titles on perpetual access basis with option for
 - Single user access
 - Three user access



- Price is based on print with mark-up applied by user concurrency
- Volume discounts are available

Evidence Based Acquisition (EBA) at OUP

- Evidence based acquisition
 allows libraries to access a large
 collection of ebooks for a fixed
 period for a fee and then make
 final purchasing decisions after
 evaluating usage data.
- EBA is a form of demand-driven acquisition that may prove to be a more sustainable long-term model than Demand Driven Acquisition (DDA) or Short Term Loan (STL).

How does EBA work?

STEP 1

We will agree the fee for EBA based on your budget and the range of titles of interest to you. Deposit your EBA funds to begin access.

STEP 2

Enjoy access to all the agreed upon titles within *Oxford Scholarship Online* (OSO) for 12 months. During this time, OUP will provide regular usage reports.

STEP 3

At the end of the 12 month period, you decide which titles you will purchase. These titles then form part of your permanent collection.
